Whenever possible, please contact our MOPPETS Coordinator, Elsie Crouse (924-7042) one or two days before MOPS to reserve a spot for your child as a MOPPETS helper. Students who desire to assist as a MOPPETS helper must arrive no later than 9:00 in order to retain a classroom assignment.

The Study Hall room will have an assigned adult who will act as a chaperone. Students are not allowed to leave the Study Hall room, with the exception of restroom visits, until the close of the MOPS morning, at which time they must be picked up by their mother. While in Study Hall, students are expected to behave respectfully, dress modestly, to follow the direction of their assigned chaperone and must not become a distraction to others. **Students are required to bring materials to work on during the course of the morning. Please be sure to provide enough material for the entire 2 hours.** Students are permitted to bring and to use electronic devices such as I-Pods, laptops, and game systems, provided that appropriate headphones are used and that they do not disturb other students. Use of cell phones during Study Hall is prohibited. Food and beverages are permitted (within reason). No food will be provided by MOPS during the course of the morning. Under no circumstances will coarse language, questionable materials, loud behavior or immodest attire be tolerated. Please note that students should be self-led in their work as the Study Hall Supervisor is not provided as a tutor or teacher's assistant, but rather an adult presence.

I understand the above requests and will communicate these requests to my child. I also understand that if these requests are not followed, I will be asked to make other arrangements for the supervision of my child during MOPS.
